

Curriculum Management Queries

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Introduction

What is a Query?

Queries are questions that you pose to the database, and in return, the database answers your question(s) based on specific criteria by providing a list of answers (results). Curriculum Management Queries are questions asked in Campus Solutions regarding courses, classes, rosters (class; attendance; and grade), and faculty. Queries are basic reports, and they are typically exported through and Excel file for further manipulation.

What is a Record (Table)?

Queries are composed of different records (tables) found within Campus Solutions. In most cases, queries can help a user extract data for a specific field and/or a specific value in a field. Records are different tables in Campus Solutions and many records can make up a page in Campus Solutions. The Record/Table stores the information for pages found in Campus Solutions.

What is a field?

A field is a specific piece or value of information, and this piece of information lives on a Record/Table.

Who can use queries?

Any San Diego Community College District employee with access to Campus Solutions can see queries through Query Viewer.

Class Schedule Queries


Class Section Audit

Purpose

The Class Section Audit query, or simply 'Audit' Query, allows a user to audit a specific class section to see if a Record/Table was updated. This query also allows a user to see the User ID of the last person to update the class section.

All Classes Scheduled

Purpose

The Classes Scheduled query allows a user to view all of the classes scheduled for a term by Campus, Department, Subject, and/or Course Number.

Class Scheduler Query

Purpose

The Class Scheduling query, allows a user to view basic information for class sections scheduled so far, including the class notes (class comments).

Search by Term and Class Number

Purpose

The Search by Term and Class Number query allows a user to search for a class section by Term and Class Number.

Learning Community – Parent Classes

Purpose

The Learning Community – Parent Classes query allows a user to identify the Learning Community Parent Classes, for example LCOM 101 or ENGL 101X.

Learning Community - Child Classes

Purpose

The Learning Community – Child Classes query allows a user to identify the Learning Community Child Classes, for example ENGL 31 and ENGL 101 (both classes children of the parent class ENGL 101X).

Faculty Information Queries

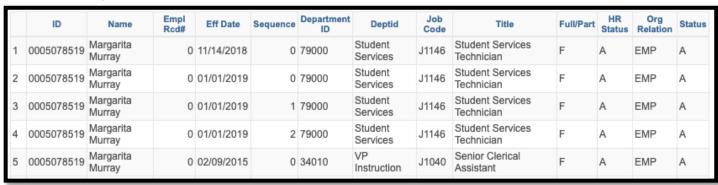
Faculty Job Records (Historical)

Purpose

The Faculty Job Records query allows a user to see basic job data (past, present, and future dated) for a specific faculty member. This query is also used to verify that faculty job data has synced from Human Resources into Campus Solutions. Salary information is not included in this query.
